## Alumni kick off the "Mustang Legacy Project"

## The project's goal: create a continuing program in which alumni names, years, and comments may be immortalized on a brick or a tile on campus.

Last year, Jay Helmantoler ('60) and Boydd Galland ('60) were tossing around a bunch of names.

"We were talking about individuals who had some kind of athletic achievement," says Jay, "people we thought should be listed in an athletic San Dieguito Hall of Fame."

As these kinds of conversations are always a lot more fun when more souls are involved, Boydd set up a Facebook group to bring the debates online. As more and more alumni joined the group and submitted their ideas, he and Jay noticed that the stories of unforgettable games were often accompanied by stories of achievements that had little to do with sports.

"People were remembering students who were Thespians, or members of CSF, or in the marching band or in some other activity," says Boydd. "There were other people and things that belonged in a Hall of Fame."

Like teachers and

staff: "Mrs. Stowell," wrote Ann Reed, "was responsible for me becoming a teacher and convincing my parents that I should go to college, and she even got me a \$500 Scholarship from her teaching organization."

"[Don Crickmore] inspired me in history and caused me to major in it later on," wrote Mike Ruddy.

Non-staff members made a memorable impact, too. "Like Ernie Hilton," says Jay. "For years and years he was the voice of Mustang football. He's the kind of guy we should remember."

Boydd and Jay wondered how alumni memories like these could be preserved—when they recalled their own participation in commemo-

rative brick programs at Petco Park and the Centennial Olympic Park in Atlanta—and thus the Mustang Legacy Project was born.

Curtis Jenkins ('60) joined the team and the three of them fine-tuned their con-

cept, deciding it should be a fundraiser for the school. When they were ready, they brought their proposal to the SDA Foundation and received the Alumni Committee's endorsement.

Now they need your help. The next step is to obtain permission from the school district to install bricks or pavers on campus. When Jay, Boydd and Curtis approach the district, they must show that there is a considerable amount of alumni interest in the project.

They hope to hand district officers a list of hundreds of names of those who intend to participate, to demonstrate that the Mustang Legacy Project is an achievable program. (The SDA Foundation will assist as a liaison between the alumni and the school district, but the school district ultimately has final approval on this project.)
