Upon returning from Korea, Lucien attended University in San Diego. He received a BA in Psychology from USIU and an MA from the Carl Rogers Institute's Center for the Study of the Person in La Jolla, CA. He began to work for San Dieguito Union High School District in 1974 and taught a variety of subjects for 30 years before retiring in 2004.

After his Retirement from teaching Lucien continued mentoring by opening up a therapy practice in Santa Fe New Mexico. He continued his lifelong vocation of helping people until the day of his passing.



Lucien is survived by his two Sons: Carter and Kellen; and both his ex-wife Nancy and his Life-Partner Michele. His life was one of stories and memories and we are all so grateful for the time we had with him.




A Remarkable Legacy
